Members and Supporters of the 116th Infantry Regiment,

It is a genuine pleasure to invite you and your guests to participate in the 58th Annual Muster and Reunion of the 116th Infantry Regiment, on Saturday, 7 November, at the Hotel 24 South, 24 S Market St, Staunton, Virginia. Our theme this year is, *"Remember 9/11... Never Forget"* commemorating the events of September 11 and the transition to the MBCT learning about the future for the Normandy Brigade.

Members of the Regiment started the Muster to maintain the friendships they had forged in military service and to preserve the distinguished history of the Regiment. Today, another generation of veterans and their supporters continue to gather annually for the same purpose: "maintaining friendships and preserving history."

Thanks to the generous support of several businesses, veteran service organizations, and friends of the 116th Infantry Regiment, and the 116th MBCT, the cost of the muster is held to \$50/person or \$100/couple. The meal choices are Chicken Marsala or Adobo Rub Pork Loin. There are a "Gluten Free" and a Vegetarian meal choice also. The main cash bar will remain open throughout the Muster Dinner and there is another for the event with DJ after-the muster until 11 PM in the Colonnade Room.

We request that you register no later than Midnight, Sunday, 1 November. We must submit the meal count the next day. **(Please note we cannot refund cancellations after this date).** Seating is limited, so we encourage you to **secure your place for the Muster either online or by mail in time for us to receive it no later than midnight Sunday, 1 November (remember to allow for postal service delays).**

Hotel 24 South will offer a special rate of \$155+tax per night (single or double occupancy) for those attending the Muster weekend events. We have a block of 30 rooms on Saturday and 10 on Friday, and is only available for a limited time. You must **make your hotel reservation no later than 7 October to receive the special rate.** If rooms are still available after that date they will honor the special rate if rooms are still available. - **Friday 6 NOV:** 29th Division Museum Open 1000-1700; (29th Division Museum address: 566 Lee Highway, Verona, VA 24482 / Ph: 540-248-0116)
- **Saturday 7NOV, 1000-1500:** Museum Open. While admission is free, donations are accepted.
- **Saturday Evening 1700-1800:** Check-in for your meal ticket will in the Colonnade Room adjacent to the 1924 Lounge with a cash bar; reception and cash bar in the area outside the Shenandoah Ballroom. ***Please pick up your meal ticket prior to 1800 as it is important to be seated at your ticketed table by 1800.***
- **Saturday Evening 1800:** The seated dinner and program will begin promptly in the Shenandoah Ballroom. There will be several traditional observances as well as the State of the Brigade presentation by the 116th MBCT *"The Normandy Brigade"* Commander, COL Arthur Moore, and the keynote address will follow. There will be a "social after-event" until 2300 in the Colonnade Room. The hotel observes quiet time beginning at 2300.
